In addition to the organized travel teams, RSC offers a recreational league in fall and spring, an indoor winter league, and several summer camps that involve an additional 450 children. RSC is now very proud to host TOPSoccer (**T**he **O**utreach **P**rogram for **S**occer) that is designed for kids ages 4 to 19 with special needs, either cognitive or physical disabilities, to enable them to become valued and successful members of the RSC family.
